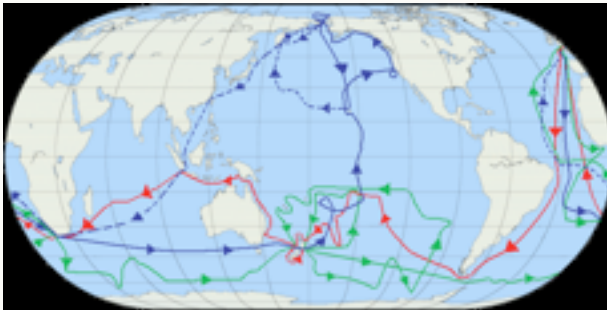
Voyage 2
