Dear Parents and Caregivers

The Junior School, Breakfast and Tabloid Games programme will take place on **Thursday 1 April.**

This special programme is an EOTC (Education Outside the Classroom) experience. It gives students opportunities to demonstrate the key competencies identified in *The New Zealand Curriculum*; such as, managing self, relating to others, and participating and contributing.

Organisation for the morning:-

Promptly at 8.00am

The children arrive at school in their pyjamas and dressing gown and assemble in the front courtyard.

We kindly ask that parents leave at this point to encourage independence. The children will then move to the classroom with their class teacher.



We will commence eating breakfast - cereal, milk, toast bread, country soft canola/dairy spread, jam and vegemite.

8.30am

The Children will wash their plate, clear tables and get ready for school.

This involves brushing their teeth, washing their hands and face, combing their hair and changing into their shorts and T-shirt.

The activities are designed **to help children develop independence.**

9.00am

Back in our classrooms ready for the learning day.

11.10am

We will have our tabloid games, starting at 11.10am, on the school field. Families are invited to watch the activities. You are welcome to join your child for lunch after the tabloid games.



Items required for this learning experience.

Please remember to NAME all items :-

- A named bag containing shorts, T-shirt, underwear and shoes. The children are **not** required to wear school uniform on this day.
- This bag will also be used to put their pyjamas etc. in after they have changed. A separate bag other than their school bag is a good idea as they will need their school bags to carry their normal school items such as lunch boxes and drink bottles.

- A bowl, a cup, a spoon with which to eat their cereal and a plate for their toast. These should be reusable plastic or eco-friendly and non-breakable.
- Please put in the clothing bag, a small towel, tea towel, toothbrush, face flannel and comb or brush (in a small toilet bag to make it easier to find) - we will supply toothpaste and soap.
- **An item can be quickly returned to its rightful owner when clearly named. Your support with this task is greatly appreciated.**
- **Please inform your child's teacher, as soon as possible, of any dietary concerns or known allergies. Thank you.**
